



# **VIENNA POLICE HIGHLIGHTS**

**December 30, 2011**

Readers are reminded that an “arrest” is based upon probable cause and does not always mean that someone was physically taken into custody. ## **INCIDENTS**

### **Police Service 11-20220**

**POSH Store**

**419 Maple Avenue, East**

**Between December 21 at 10:30 p.m. and December 22 at 8:00 a.m.**

An employee reported that unknown subjects had been drinking alcohol behind the business and leaving the bottles behind.

One vehicle was travelling along eastbound Maple Avenue. A second vehicle pulled out from James Madison Drive and attempted to turn left on to eastbound Maple Avenue. In doing so it struck the first vehicle.

The driver of the turning vehicle was charged with Failure to Yield the Right of Way.

**Lakewood Drive near Drake Street, SW 11-20039**

**December 18 1:45 p.m.**

Two side by side vehicles were stopped on Lakewood Drive. The right hand vehicle attempted to merge left and struck the other vehicle.

The driver of the striking vehicle was charged with Failure to Pay Full Time and Attention.

**Courthouse Road near Maple Avenue, West 11-20133**

**December 20 11:55 a.m.**

Two in- line vehicles were travelling along southbound Courthouse Road. As the front vehicle slowed to make a left turn, it was struck in the rear by the second vehicle.

The driver of the striking vehicle was charged with Following Too Closely.

**Maple Avenue at Westbriar Drive, NE 11-20145**

**December 20 3:45 p.m.**

Two in- line vehicles had stopped on Maple Avenue for congested traffic. A third vehicle approached from the rear and struck the second vehicle, which in turn struck the first vehicle.

The driver of the initial striking vehicle was charged with Reckless Driving.

**Parking Lot of 111 Church Street, NW 11-20156**

**Hit and Run**

**December 21 10:48 p.m.**

A legally parked vehicle was struck by an unknown vehicle. The driver of the striking vehicle left no contact information.

**Kingsley Road at Cottage Street, SW 11-20233**

**December 22 9:13 p.m.**

Two perpendicular vehicles simultaneously arrived at a 4- way stop sign. Both vehicles started moving at the same time and collided in the intersection.

**400 Block Center Street near Mill Street, NE 11-20294**

**December 24 7:13 a.m.**

A vehicle travelling along northbound Center Street struck a legally parked vehicle. It is believed that the driver of the striking vehicle was swerving to avoid a deer.

**Maple Avenue near Follin Lane, SE 11-20303**

**Hit and Run**

**December 25 7:57 p.m.**

Two in- line vehicles were travelling along Follin Lane. As the front vehicle slowed to stop, it was struck in the rear by a second vehicle. The striking vehicle and driver then sped away without providing any contact information.

**Maple Avenue at Nutley Street, SW 11-20377**

**December 27 11:51 a.m.**

Two side by side vehicles were travelling along westbound Maple Avenue approaching Nutley Street. At the intersection the leftmost vehicle cut in front of the other vehicle and attempted to turn right on to Nutley Street. While doing so the turning vehicle was struck by the other vehicle.

The driver of the turning vehicle was charged with Failure to Pay Full Time and Attention.

**Mill Street at Church Street, NE 11-20383**

Two opposing vehicles simultaneously arrived at a 4-way stop sign. Both vehicles then entered the intersection at the same time. One of the vehicles then attempted to turn left in front of the other vehicle and was struck.

**December 28 3:11 p.m.**

As one vehicle pulled out from a driveway and attempted to turn right on to Ayrhill Avenue, it struck a passing vehicle.

**Park Street at Moore Avenue, SE 11-20459**

**December 29 7:33 a.m.**

Two perpendicular vehicles simultaneously arrived at a 4- way stop sign. Both vehicles started moving at the same time and collided in the intersection.

The driver of the vehicle which did not have the right of way (vehicle to the left of the second vehicle) was charged with Failure to Yield the Right of Way.
