



Town of Vienna, Virginia Police Department Media Information Release

On October 13, 2007 at approximately 2:13 P.M. Officer Fred Lewis of the Vienna Police Department responded to the Vienna Drug Center at 150 West Maple Avenue for an individual that had uttered a forged prescription. Upon his arrival, Officer Lewis located a subject matching the description of the suspect behind the Magruder's store. Officer Lewis began observing the subject and followed him as he re-entered the Vienna Drug Center to pick up the prescription. The subject was identified as Amir David Rahnemoon, Middle Eastern Male, 36YOA, of Misty Dawn Court in Herndon, Virginia.

As Officer Lewis informed the subject he was under arrest and grasped his arm, the subject fled from Officer Lewis and ran towards the front of the store. As Mr. Rahnemoon was fleeing, the suspect pushed an elderly female store patron to the ground causing her minor injuries. The suspect exited the store and fled down Maple Avenue towards Lawyers Road. Officer Lewis continued to pursue Mr. Rahnemoon and as he ran behind the Money and King Funeral Home, MPO Randy Burchfield of the Vienna Police Department confronted the suspect and ordered him to the ground. Mr. Rahnemoon complied and was taken in to custody and subsequently transported to the Fairfax County Adult Detention Center where he is being held on a \$12,500 bond.

Mr. Rahnemoon was charged with Attempting to Obtain a Controlled Substance by Forgery, two counts of Obtaining a Controlled Substance by Forgery, Assault and Battery, and Resisting Arrest.
