Man Abducted and Threatened With a Knife



On July 4, 2008 at approximately 2:11 p.m., units from the Town of Vienna Police Department responded to the 100 Block of Lewis Street, NW for a reported assault. After arriving, an officer began interviewing the complainant in Spanish.

The complainant reported that earlier in the day at approximately 2:00 a.m. another individual that lives in the home had attempted to make contact with the victim. The victim was sleeping and had his door locked so the subject was unsuccessful in making contact.

Later on that same morning, the victim awoke and came out of his bedroom. He was approached by the same individual, Vicente De Jesus Carrion Espinosa, 42, of Lewis Street in Vienna, and told to go run an errand for him. The victim refused and was then threatened with a knife. The victim fled and secreted himself in a bedroom.

The arrested subject forced the victim to remain in his room under threat of violence for approximately 4 hours. At approximately 2:00 p.m. the victim was able to exit the room and call the police.

Officers entered the home and found the suspect, Mr. Carrion Espinosa. He was arrested and charged with Abduction by Force and transported to the Fairfax County Adult Detention Center where he is being held without bond.
