Multiple Burglaries in Southeast Vienna

On January 9, 2008 patrol units from the Town of Vienna Police Department responded to Silva's Patisserie Bakery in the 100 Block of Glyndon Street S.E. Vienna for a reported burglary. Their investigation revealed that some time during the night, subjects had smashed out the front door glass and stolen items to include a cash register from inside the business. While talking with the complainant, Officer Pat Shaw observed that the front door to a nearby barber shop had been smashed out as well.

Officer Shaw and Officer Dean Bailey searched both of the businesses to determine if the suspects were still inside. Their search revealed no suspects inside of either location. Officer Steve Simon then began searching around the exterior of the buildings as well as nearby parking areas and found the cash register which had been removed from the bakery. It appeared that the cash had been removed from the register drawer prior to being discarded.

While collecting evidence from the first two burglary scenes, it was learned that there may be a third burglary. It appeared that subjects had attempted to pry open the door to the Café Renaissance Restaurant in the same area. It did not appear that the individuals gained entry into the restaurant however they did damage the door and lock mechanism.
