Bicyclist Strikes Town of Vienna Police Cruiser

On June 17, 2008 at approximately 6:25 p.m. a Town of Vienna Police Officer was stopped at the intersection of Center Street and Maple Avenue, SE. The cruiser had begun making a right turn from Center Street on to eastbound Maple Avenue.

A female adult bicyclist was stopped at the SE corner of Maple Avenue and Center Street waiting to traverse Center Street. As the police cruiser was in the process of turning, it was struck on the passenger side front door. The bicyclist sustained a minor abrasion to her knee.

The Fairfax County Fire and Rescue Department was summoned to check out the bicyclist. After assessing her injury, they departed without transporting her. The cruiser and bicycle both sustained minor damage. No charges were filed as a result of the crash.
