Elderly Resident Dies After Fall

On June 17, 2009 at approximately 5:00 p.m. a communications installation technician had completed installation of service and was attempting to leave the residence of an elderly male in the 500 Block of Ayrhill Avenue, NE. The homeowner was dissatisfied with the completion of the installation and followed the technician out to his van.

The homeowner continued to express his dissatisfaction and tried to block the technician's van from leaving his driveway. When the homeowner moved to the side of the van, the technician began to drive away. As this occurred the homeowner reached in through the van window and grabbed the steering wheel.

The elderly homeowner fell to the ground and sustained life threatening injuries. He was transported to an area hospital by Fairfax County EMS and died overnight.

The investigation of this incident is continuing in conjunction with the Medical Examiner's Office.
