



Town of Vienna, Virginia Police Department Media Information Release

On October 10, 2007 at approximately 12:31 A.M., Officer Matt Maiorana was on patrol in the Town of Vienna when he observed a white Lincoln with Maryland registration fail to stop for a stop sign. Officer Maiorana continued to follow the vehicle and observed several more traffic violations and conducted a traffic stop in the 500 block of Maple Avenue, West. Officer Maiorana obtained the driver's information and continued with his investigation. The driver was identified as 20 year old Eric A. Wright of Oxon Hill, Maryland. Officer Maiorana then checked the driver's status with regards to warrants and got a confirmation that there were several warrants for Mr. Wright on file in Maryland. Officer Maiorana then called for back up units as there were other occupants in the vehicle and detained the driver until he could verify the validity of the warrants. The warrants were confirmed and Mr. Wright was placed under arrest based on the charges in Prince Georges County, Maryland. Mr. Wright was wanted for 2 counts of Robbery with a Deadly Weapon, 1st Degree Assault, 2 counts of Robbery, Theft over \$500, Use of a Handgun in a Crime of Violence, and Theft under \$500. Mr. Wright was arrested and transported to the Fairfax County Adult Detention Center where he is being held awaiting extradition to Maryland.
