Town of Vienna Vehicle Strikes Pedestrian

On January 28, 2008 at approximately 6:56 A.M., Mr. Vernon Anderson, 58, a Town of Vienna Water and Sewer Department Supervisor, was involved in an accident in which a pedestrian was struck at Park Street and Maple Avenue in Vienna. The vehicle he was operating was a Town owned truck belonging to the Water and Sewer Department.

Mr. Anderson was travelling Northbound on Park Street approaching Maple Avenue. As Mr. Anderson's vehicle turned left from Park Street on to Maple Avenue, it struck a pedestrian walking in the crosswalk. The pedestrian, a 56 year old female from Haymarket, Virginia was transported to Fairfax Hospital with injuries resulting from the crash. The pedestrian was walking in a marked crosswalk and the driver, Mr. Anderson, stated he did not see her. The pedestrian sustained a broken leg as well as a head injury. None of the injuries were determined to be life- threatening.

The driver of the vehicle, Mr. Vernon Anderson, was charged with a violation of 46.2-924 - Failing to yield to a pedestrian crossing a highway.
