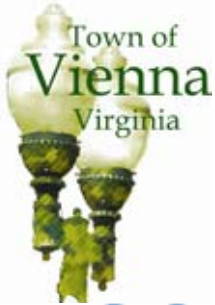

Televisions, computers and peripheral devices (such as keyboards, speakers, printers, scanners, etc.) will be accepted for recycling at **no charge**. **Please do not bring electrical household appliances (such as vacuums, microwaves, toaster ovens, etc.) to this event.**

DOCUMENT SHREDDING

In order to accommodate as many residents as possible at this event, a limit of **5 reasonably-sized boxes of paper per household** will be accepted for shredding. **There is no fee for this service. Please remove paper from binders and remove binder clips. All shredded paper will be recycled.**

COMPACT FLUORESCENT LIGHT RECYCLING

We will be accepting compact fluorescent light bulbs for recycling at this event. Only **compact** fluorescent light bulbs will be accepted. **Long fluorescent tubes and broken bulbs will not be accepted at this event.** These items must be taken to one of the county's permanent household hazardous waste disposal sites at the I-66 Transfer Station (Fairfax) or I-95 Landfill (Lorton) Complex.
