



# VIENNA POLICE HIGHLIGHTS

## **INCIDENTS**

### **Mental Case 16-004907**

**Hillcrest Drive, SW**

**June 9 4:53 p.m.**

Officers went to the listed address to assist Fairfax County Mental Health Evaluators. The male subject was determined not to be in need of assistance.
