Mill Street reconstruction project gets underway April 11

Work to reconstruct the pavement and upgrade three drainage structures along Mill Street is scheduled to get underway April 11. The road construction project will extend from Ayr Hill Avenue to 430 Mill Street and may require up to six weeks to complete.

Access to businesses and parking areas along Mill Street will be maintained at all times. In order to minimize duration of the project and its overall impact on the corridor, much of the work will continue overnight. Traffic control measures will be used 24 hours/day as needed.

Those not traveling to Mill Street businesses are encouraged to find other routes. Mill Street business customers and visitors are asked not to park on portions of the road that are closed. No utility disruptions are anticipated.
