Parking update

The Town of Vienna is considering purchasing a floor of a proposed four-story building on Mill Street that would provide about 127 public parking spaces. A public hearing on this topic was held at the February 26 Council meeting, at which 27 people spoke, voicing support, opposition, concerns, and questions.

Town staff will provide written responses to questions that can be answered via the Town website later this month. As contract details and information are still being ironed out, it likely will be April when Council considers whether or not to
