

Approved Street Tree List and Planting Guide 2019



GUIDING PRINCIPLES

During plan review, when applicable, the Town Arborist will determine the number and types of street trees to be used. All planting shall be done in accordance with guidelines established in the ANSI A300 Standards for Tree Care Operations. This guide can be found at www.treecareindustry.org.

Trees should be a minimum of 2” caliper

Trees should be planted 20’ apart, 15’ AT MINIMUM

Trees should be planted AT MINIMUM 5’ from any underground utilities

Trees should only be planted on utility strips AT LEAST 5’ wide

When planting street trees, follow guidelines set forth by the Tree Care Industry Association. www.treecareindustry.org
